Membership Fees & Payment Policy



Overview

1. Membership fees Membership fees will be set and approved at the beginning of the Fiscal year by the Board of Directors.

2. Types of Membership fees:

- Recreational Fees – Associated to the recreational programs (Fall/Winter/Spring/Summer) house leagues
- Competitive Fees – Associated to the competitive programs (1 year – starting at the beginning of the Competitive program (Sept/Oct)
- Program Fees – Associated to the add-on programs (Summer camps, Skilz camps/Clinics, Holiday camps/PA Day camps)

2.1 Adjustments to Membership fees Adjustments to the various membership fees can be done by approval of the Board of directors as required through the year and with proper notification to the membership, via email, website. Changes to the yearly set membership fees must be approved by the board and communicated to the Membership.

2.2 Recreational Fees Recreational fees are those applied to the Recreational (House League) programs. These are seasonal fees, are determined by the Organization, and approved by the board prior to the start of the program.

2.3 Competitive fees Competitive fees are applied for the Competitive program and set yearly at the beginning of the competitive season. These fees are determined by the club and approved by the board.

2.4 Program Fees Program fees are for those add-on programs, summer camps, day care session, skill sessions. These fees are determined by the club and approved by the board prior to the beginning of the Session/program.

3. Payment of the Membership fees Payment of the membership fees for Recreational, Competitive and Programs, is mandatory to participate in the activity. Failure to pay the fees will result in immediate suspension of the membership until such time the fees have been paid.

Schedule of payment of the Fees is determined by the club and approved by the board and will be communicated to the Members prior to the beginning of the Program.

4. Failure to pay Membership fees Failure to pay memberships fees will result in the suspension of the membership to be for all activities (practice and games) until all outstanding fees are paid. In case the payment is done in instalments, failure to pay any of the instalments will result in immediate suspension of the membership for all activities (Training sessions, games, skills sessions, etc)

Coaches will be notified of the player/participant suspension and will not allow the participant to enter the fields or participate in any activity until the club has notified the coach of the player ability to return to play. Coaches that do not comply with these rules will be subject to disciplinary actions by the

club/Board. Members that violate their suspension will be subject to have their membership revoked permanently and be barred from participating in any activity with the Organization in the future.

5. Accounts from previous Seasons: If a member wants to join the club and their account is in arrears, the balance owed will have to be paid in full prior to the start of the new season. No offers will be made to players with outstanding balance from the previous season.

6. Financial assistance programs: The club interest in to provide Soccer related activities to as many kids as possible. If a player is interested in participating in the club programming but is unable to pay its own fees, they are encouraged to contact the club at info@miltonmagic.com to inquire about financial support opportunities.

All request of financial support will be reviewed by the club/Board to validate they meet the requirements/criteria and will be at the discretion of the club/board to approve.

The club approved by the board will reserve an amount to subsidise players that do require financial assistance. Members interested in applying for such support will be required to apply for financial assistance and complete the attached form for review by the club/board. Once the review has been completed notification of the results will be directly communicated to the members via email to their provided contact details.

Financial assistance will only apply to membership fees. Subsidised players that participate in competitive programs will be required to participate and contribute on any additional funds required by the team (Fundraising for tournaments, Hotels expenses and accommodations of players, etc.).
